



BOLT CUSTOM TRUCKS AND MANUFACTURING

LIMITED WARRANTY

This limited warranty outlines the rights and responsibilities of Bolt Custom Trucks and Manufacturing (we or us) to the original purchaser (you) in connection with your purchase of our custom sleeper systems.

WHAT THE WARRANTY COVERS

We warrant each new sleeper manufactured and installed by us for a period of twelve (12) months from the date of delivery to you to be free from defects in materials and workmanship under normal use and service. In the event of a defect in material or workmanship, which includes a defect in the paint finish, we, at our option, will repair or replace any defective or failed part or parts within twelve (12) months after delivery of the sleeper to you.

WHAT THE WARRANTY DOES NOT COVER

The following items are not covered by our limited warranty:

- Damage of any kind or nature to any part of the vehicle to which the sleeper is affixed, including, without limitation, the day cab, chassis or items supplied by the chassis manufacturer, engine, wheels, axles, and driveline.
- Rust and corrosion or damage caused by factors beyond our control such as airborne fallout (including chemicals, tree sap, etc.) stones, hail, earthquake, water, acid rain, flooding, windstorms, lightning, road salt, road salt spray, blowing sand, road surface debris, galvanic corrosion, or other environmental factors.
- Routine service and maintenance items, including, without limitation, light bulb replacement, battery replacement, fuses, and similar items.
- Separately manufactured items installed by us, including, but not limited to: generators, inverters, appliances, entertainment equipment, satellites, hot water heater, heater/air conditioner, roof top air conditioner, interior and exterior lights, air ride systems, windows, doors, and similar equipment. Such items are covered by warranties supplied by the manufacturer of those components.
- Hitches for tow bodies are covered by their manufacturers' warranty.
- Components, parts or materials supplied by customers for installation in their trucks / sleepers.

- Normal wear and tear.
- Damage as a result of neglect, misuse and abuse, collision, any unauthorized alteration or modification from factory specifications, accident, improper maintenance, unauthorized repair or installations, freezing temperatures, off road use, vandalism or theft, and similar problems.
- We are not liable for downtime expense or loss of revenue. We are not liable for travel expenses related to transporting the truck and sleeper to us or another repair facility. We are not liable for the replacement cost of any clothing, food, electronic devices that we have not installed or other items purchased by you and stored within the truck or sleeper.

HOW TO MAKE A WARRANTY CLAIM

To make a warranty claim, you must be original purchaser, you must have registered the sleeper within 30 days of delivery to you, you must contact us within one year of delivery of the sleeper to you, and you must return the sleeper to us, at your cost and expense, for inspection and, if problems with the sleeper are covered by this warranty, repair or replacement.

We will make Warranty Repairs only at our facility in Fort Wayne, Indiana.

THIRD PARTY REPAIRS

We may authorize certain qualified third party repairs for warranty cost reimbursement only under our strict review, technical guidance and cost control. However, this warranty repair must be approved by us in advance of the repair activity taking place. In order to initiate our approval for a third party repair with warranty cost reimbursement, you or the third party must contact us in advance. You will need to submit a full description of the defective issue and an estimate of repair cost including a breakdown parts and labor cost. As well, you will need to provide your VIN, mileage and Bolt serial number.

If we approve the third party repair, then we will issue a Repair Authorization number for a predetermined amount to cover this repair. After conducting the repair activities, the third party must submit an invoice to us which details the billable amount in accordance with the Repair Authorization. In addition defective materials must be returned to us for review before this payment will be made.

Unauthorized repairs or attempted repairs which do not comply with the procedures detailed above will not be reimbursed as a valid warranty repair. Furthermore, if a third party conducts unauthorized repairs or attempted repairs and this results in further damage to the sleeper, truck or even bodily injury, then it will not be covered by this limited warranty or our product liability insurance.

REGISTRATION

You must submit the Limited Warranty Registration Card provided at the time of purchase or a replacement warranty card obtained from us within 30 days of delivery of the product in order to activate warranty coverage. If a Limited Warranty Registration Card is not submitted to us within that period, your limited warranty will be void.

WE FURTHER DISCLAIM ANY LIABILITY ARISING FROM ANY OTHER THEORY, INCLUDING PRODUCT LIABILITY, NEGLIGENCE, DEFECTIVE DESIGN, MANUFACTURING DEFECT, FAILURE TO WARN, LACK OF ROADWORTHINESS AND ANY THEORY NOT EXPRESSLY COVERED UNDER THE TERMS HEREOF. The remedies set forth herein shall be exclusive, and in no event shall we be liable for anticipated profits or for incidental or consequential damages. Our liability on any claim of any kind for any loss or damage arising out of or in connection with or resulting from the purchase of our products or from the performance or failure of those products shall in no case exceed the fair market value of such products at the time a claim is made hereunder. If we should provide any coverage in excess of what is required hereunder, such coverage shall not act as a waiver and will in no way bind us to provide similar coverage to any customer in the future.

To the extent that any warranty is disclaimed hereunder but may not be disclaimed under applicable law, such warranty will be limited to the lesser of one year from the date of delivery or the applicable period required by law.

The terms and conditions contained herein, as well as those of any documents prepared in conjunction with the sale of the sleeper system may not be modified, altered or waived by any action, inaction or representations, whether oral or in writing, except upon the express written authorization of an executive officer of Bolt.

Should repairs become necessary under the terms of this Limited Warranty, the extent of that repair will be determined solely by us.

The terms hereof apply only to the original purchaser and may not be transferred to any other person or entity.
